

South Church Fall Community Retreat

Columbus Weekend October 5-8, 2018

Information and Registration Form

Come share a weekend of re-creation and rejuvenation with your friends from South Church. This year we return to Geneva Point Retreat Center on beautiful Lake Winnepesaukee. The retreat is scheduled for the long Columbus Day holiday weekend, beginning Friday night and ending at noon on Monday. You have the option to stay three nights or just Friday and Saturday nights. This is a collaborative retreat and we encourage all participants to share their interests, skills and talents with the larger community. You can help out with building the bonfire, making coffee in the Inn, and staying to clean up at the end of the weekend for example.

The Fall Community Retreat has become an annual tradition at South Church. This gathering offers the opportunity to know other church members and friends in a deeper more intimate way. Because the group is small when compared to the overall church membership (about 40-50 people attend), it is easier to make new friends, reaffirm old ones, and know ourselves better through workshops and activities. Each year welcomes a well-rounded mix of veterans as well as newcomers. Children are welcome and encouraged to attend. If needed, financial assistance may be available.

Housing

Our group will be housed on the second floor of the Inn building and in the Chapel Line cabins. The Inn features a spacious lobby, the central meeting place, where many activities are held. With *no central heating - just a large wood stove*, it is a lot like camping. Other wheelchair accessible accommodations are available. The rooms on the second floor of the Inn feature two single beds and we encourage assigning two people per room. Families who sign up for the second floor of the Inn will be assigned adjacent rooms. The Chapel Line cabins will be available for groups of 2 or up to 4 people. The cabins have a set of bunk beds and two twin beds. We will reserve a section of the second floor for families so that there is an option for parents to put their children to bed and come down to the first floor of the Inn for social time at night. When you arrive you will be given your room assignment.

Accommodations

On the second floor of the Inn there are common bathrooms with hot showers. In the Chapel Line cabins there is central heat with a bathroom that includes a shower. Pillows and blankets are provided. Sleeping bags or warm blankets are strongly suggested. **Rooms are assigned in order of receipt by the registrar.**

Meals

The cost of registration includes all meals beginning with breakfast on Saturday through lunch on Monday. We have requested vegetarian options. Meals are offered buffet-style in the dining hall and there has always been plenty to eat. The committee provides snacks and beverages in the Inn. You are also allowed to bring your own snacks and beverages including beer and wine.

Activities and Workshops

Attendees facilitate the activities and workshops; therefore, they are as diverse as the group itself. Past offerings have included: meditation, yoga, poetry, writing, tai chi, improvisation, crafts, drawing & painting, prayer flag construction, tarot, music, board games, 'new' games, pumpkin-carving, guided nature walk, hiking, dancing, singing, and always a bonfire gathering. Musicians are encouraged to bring instruments. There is no additional cost for workshops. There are great hiking trails and fields to explore. Bring poems, songs and other things to share at the community bonfire.

Children

This is an all-church retreat and children are welcome! Children can participate in many of the workshop offerings and family activities. Child-centered activities and child supervision have occurred so parents can participate in workshops. If you have an interest or talent working with children, please let us know.
